Delta Striped Bass Fishing Tournament June 21th Rules:

DF&W licensed, currently paid RT member-only, with a liability waiver on file, may qualify for tournament cash prizes. Two member-teams per boat or two-member team fishing from shore, may enter the contest by posting their names on a sign-up sheet along with a \$20 entry fee per angler at on or before our June 16th breakfast meeting. Members may also mail their name and \$20 entry fee check to: RTFC, P.O. Box 7441, Auburn, CA 95604.

A Rooster Tail boat-owner may pre-arrange with the tournament coordinator to have two senior RT members with physical or age related limitations to fish as a team. The boat owner would not fish, but may provide assistance, e.g. netting, bait, or tackle and be responsible for his passenger's well-being.

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th cash prizes will be awarded at the July 21th breakfast meeting. If no 2nd, 3rd, or 4th place winners, the related prize money will carry-over to a future member-only tournament. The anticipated \$1,000 cash prize-pool will be based on all entry fees received plus a \$100 club contribution for every 10 teams participating.

Each two-person team must present ONE bag with TWO-STRIPERS (NOT LESS THEN 18" EACH) ENTRY WITH A TOTAL COMBINED LENGTH CLOSEST TO, BUT NOT EXCEEDING THE TARGET LENGTH OF 49 INCHES. No one fish entries. Ties for the same target length entry will be decided by the heaviest of the two-fish length entries. Same length and weight ties will result in the prize money being equally split between the two teams. Participants are encouraged to release all large 'hen' female stripers to perpetuate the future of the Delta striper species and not include them as a tournament entry.

Only legally caught stripers qualify for an entry. One club measuring device will be used to determine winning lengths. Tournament entries must be submitted no later than 2:00 p.m. as per the event coordinator's cell phone's time. Entries after 2:00 p.m. or over the target length will not qualify for a prize.

Team members are to make a general announcement via VHF marine radio, channel 68, or in person at the boat launch ramp when they enter the water and when leaving the water. If team participants choose to leave the tournament area before the 2:00 p.m. contest check-in, please advise the tournament coordinator.
