## *Stampede Reservoir Camping - Campgrounds and RV Parks*

The Rooster Tails Fishing Club provides annual special events for club members that to include family and friends beyond just fishing. The Rooster Tails Adventure Travel Trips are organized for camping, touring/exploring, fishing, and group fun. Our club's Board of Directors look for reasonable travel time, anticipated weather conditions, camping and hotel accommodations, and sightseeing alternatives, and of course fishing opportunities, before selecting **Stampede Lake as this year's destination site**. Stampede Lake is located North of Truckee. Driving time from the Auburn Elks Lodge via I-80 to Truckee and up to the campgrounds is around two hours.

### ***Getting to Stampede Reservoir***

Take Interstate 80 east from Truckee about 7 miles to **Boca**. At **Boca** along Interstate 80 turn north onto **Stampede Dam Road** (also called Stampede Meadows Road). Follow that road 9 miles north to **Dog Valley Road**, passing Boca Reservoir along the way. Turn left onto Dog Valley and follow it across the dam and on to the campsites and launch ramp (about 3 miles).

From **Reno** go west 26 miles on Interstate 80 to **Boca** and then follow the above directions.

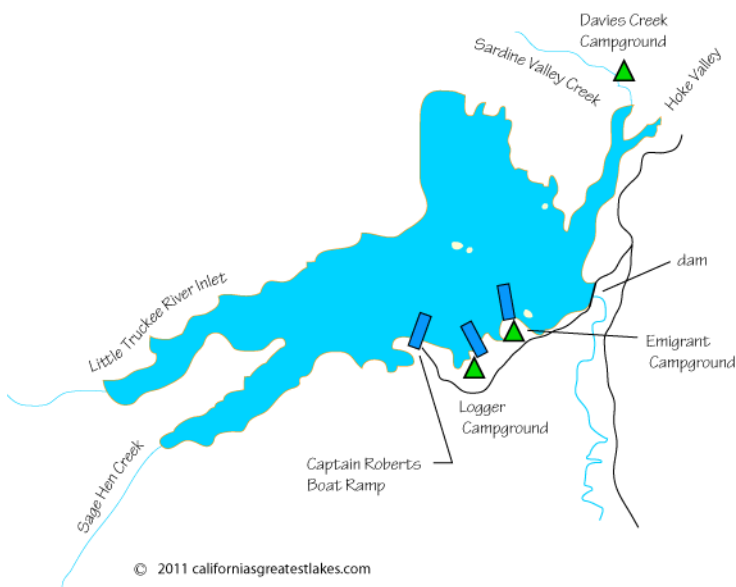

### Stampede Reservoir Map



**Stampede Reservoir** has two National Forest campgrounds right at the lake, one of them a group campground. Camping is in lightly pine-forested, chaparral country. Both campgrounds accept reservations.



Only a short distance from the reservoir, little **Davies Creek Campground** has seven rather primitive sites, while back down the road around **Boca Reservoir** are several campgrounds. Those tend to be more exposed with few trees. They are popular with people who are mostly interested in fishing. More campgrounds are found at **Prosser Reservoir**

There is a pair of RV parks in nearby Truckee and another over the pass in Cisco Grove. Sandy Beach Campground at **Tahoe Vista** along Lake Tahoe has 44 RV Sites. To the east in nearby Boomtown, Nevada, is a KOA Campground with more than 200 RV sites.
